Kristi Wysocki is a FEI 4\* Dressage, a FEI 5\* Para Dressage Judge and a U.S. Equestrian Federation licensed Dressage Sport Horse judge. She has judged CDIs and CPEDs in both the U.S., Europe and Australia. She judged the para dressage at both the 2018 World Equestrian Games and the 2017 European Para Dressage Championships. She has judged the USDF National Dressage Championships, USEF Dressage Festival and Young Horse Championships and many USDF Regional Championships. Kristi has served on the USEF Test Writing Working Group for the last eight years, including the last two publications. She is intimately familiar with the changes made and the logic behind those changes

Kristi has trained and ridden dressage from young horses to grand prix. She has competed several horses to the FEI levels, winning many championships through Grand Prix. She has also successfully competed in the CDI arena with multiple horses. She has earned her bronze, silver and gold medals from the USDF. Kristi uses her background in engineering to help relate the biomechanics of the horse and rider to her students to make understanding the sport easier. Her students range from beginners to FEI and she loves teaching both. Several students have also competed successfully through the Grand Prix Level.

She is a member of the U.S. Equestrian International Disciplines Council, member of the USEF Technical advisory committee, co-chair of the USDF Sport Horse Committee, and faculty member for the USDF Sport Horse Seminars.
